Clery Compliance

In an effort to provide timely and accurate information to our students, staff, and faculty members, the following information is being provided to you so that you can make informed decisions about your safety.

The UT Police Department has been investigating a rash of motor vehicle thefts and burglaries on campus over the last two weeks.

Since late September, four vehicle thefts have occurred, three of which were Jeeps. Additionally, UTPD has been notified of at least 10 vehicle burglaries. A majority of the vehicle thefts and burglaries occurred in garages.

UT Police would like to offer these tips to help prevent vehicle thefts and burglaries:

- Lock your car
- Take your keys with you
- Close and lock all windows and doors when you park
- Never leave your vehicle while it is running
- Remove or hide all valuables from plain view

The [Clery Act](#) requires the university to notify the campus community of certain criminal activity that occurs on university owned or controlled property. In addition, the university is required to provide safety tips that may aid in the prevention of similar crimes. The intent of a warning regarding a criminal incident(s) is to enable individuals to protect themselves.

For Safety Notices and Clery statistics, crimes are classified according to the regulations of the Clery Act mandated by the Department of Education. Though state law may categorize an incident differently, [Clery definitions and classifications](#) are strictly followed when labeling an incident for Clery reporting purposes.
