

Clery Compliance

In an effort to provide timely and accurate information to our students, staff, and faculty members, the following information is being provided to you so that you can make informed decisions about your safety.

On Sunday, June 11, 2023, UT Police were contacted in regard to two fondling incidents, that appear to be committed by the same individual.

Incident 1: A student reported an act of fondling to UT Police, that occurred while walking near the RecSports parking lot. The individual stated that they were grabbed on the buttocks by a male, who then ran and left the scene in an older model white Dodge Charger with black fenders and quarter panels.

Incident 2: An individual reported an act of fondling to UT Police, that occurred in the vicinity of Andy Holt Avenue and UT Drive. The individual stated that they were grabbed on the buttocks by a male, who then ran.

Both incidents occurred around Noon, and UT Police were contacted about both incidents. The investigation is ongoing as investigators work to gather more information.

Information we want you to know about your safety and the safety of all Volunteers.

- Report criminal or suspicious activity immediately to the nearest uniformed police officer.
- Report criminal incidents as soon as possible so appropriate measures can be taken for your safety and the safety of others.
- If you see something that doesn't look right or makes you feel concerned, please report that as well.
- In the event of an attack:
 - Get to a safe place
 - Contact law enforcement immediately

The <u>Clery Act</u> requires the university to notify the campus community of certain criminal activity that occurs on university owned or controlled property. In addition, the university is required to provide safety tips that may aid in the prevention of similar crimes. The intent of a warning regarding a criminal incident(s) is to enable individuals to protect themselves. For Safety Notices and Clery statistics, crimes are classified according to the regulations of the Clery Act mandated by the Department of Education. Though state law may categorize an incident differently, <u>Clery definitions and classifications</u> are strictly followed when labeling an incident for Clery reporting purposes.
